Topic Focus: Close of the Lord's Prayer Table Talk Discussion Questions



Table Talk Activity:

Experiential Activity Have each member of your family lie on the floor or in a comfortable position. Dim the lights and try to make sure there are few to no visual distractions.

Ask each person to read the Lord's Prayer one petition at a time. After each petition, take 1 minute to visualize that statement. After each minute have confirmands write down what they visualized. At the end of the activity discuss.

“Our Father who art in heaven | hallowed be thy name | thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven | Give us this day our daily bread | and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us | and lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil | for thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.

1. Go through petition by petition and share what each person visualized.
2. Why is it important to understand what the Lord's Prayer is really saying?
3. How would you respond to the question “Does God really answer our prayers?”
4. In what way can the Lord's Prayer be a blessing for a person's prayer life?
5. Why do we end the Lord's prayer with the word amen?

Close:

End your time in prayer- whether prayer requests, prayer partners, or just a general prayer thanking God for the ways we can know truths about Him and about ourselves.
